### ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister for Handlooms and Textiles has made the following announcement on the floor of the assembly on 27.06.2024 (Announcement No.2):-

"ஜவுளித் தொழில் முனைவோர்களுக்கு தொழில்நுட்ப ஜவுளித் துறையில் குறுகிய காலப் பயிற்சித் திட்டம் (Short Term Training on Technical Textiles) செயல்படுத்தப்படும்."

2. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Textiles (FAC) in the letter read above has submitted the proposal for implementing the short term training on Technical Textiles to impart skill development to the enthusiastic entrepreneurs through the implementing agencies which, brings together the Centres of Excellences and the Entrepreneurs to disseminate the technologies and skill development in the twelve segments of the Technical Textiles. The announcement will be implemented through the empaneled Implementing Agencies (IAs) under the purview of National Technical Textile Mission (NTTM).

**Objectives of the Short Term Training on Technical Textiles:**

- i) Establishment of reservoir of skilled individuals for recruitment in the industry.
- ii) Imparting knowledge through training about the various segments of Technical Textiles, the type of machineries needed, manufacturing procedures, investments, the products created by Centres of Excellences and the Entrepreneurs (CoEs) and transfer of Technical know-how from CoEs to trainees.
- iii) Development of transferable skills adaptable across companies.
- iv) Formation of a robust knowledge and skill ecosystem.
- v) Seamless integration of qualified professionals into diverse roles, promoting a dynamic and agile workforce.
- vi) Fostering a culture of continuous learning within the organization promoting innovation and adaptability.

The Scheme would target training of 200 individuals encompassing professionals seeking upskilling or reskilling and entrepreneurs engaged in the various application areas of Technical Textiles.

**Phase of Short Term Training on Technical Textiles:**

The implementation of Scheme shall be covering various segments of Technical Textiles according to the requirements of growing needs and strategically important segments of Technical Textiles like Agrotech, Buildtech, Geotech, Indutech, Meditech, Mobiltech, Protech, Clothtech, Homotech, Oekotech, Sportech, and Packtech.

**Funding for the Scheme under National Technical Textile Mission:**

Under NTTM guidelines, the skill development and training cost proposed by the implementing agency shall be jointly funded by the Ministry of Textiles and the trainee contribution. The trainee contribution shall be borne by the Government of Tamil Nadu. Maximum amount that can be funded by Ministry of Textiles for skill development and training programs,

as applicable to Implementing Agency conducting these programs for the relevant target group shall be Rs.10,000/- as shown in the following table.

3. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Textiles has proposed to train 200 enthusiastic entrepreneurs and the trainee fee of Rs.5,000/- Per trainee totalling Rs.10 Lakhs may be borne by Government of Tamil Nadu. The training can be imparted in the jurisdictional area of the office of the Regional Deputy Directors- Textiles (Salem, Karur, Tirupur and Madurai). Also, the Deputy Directors of four Regional Offices have extended their support and monitoring the training mechanism of institutes. The budget for conducting the Short Term Training on Technical Textiles for the entrepreneurs has been estimated as below.

The Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Textiles (FAC) has therefore requested the Government to consider the above proposal to sanction a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- as trainee fee for 200 persons at Rs.5,000/- per trainee of the short term training on Technical Textiles to impart Skill Development to the entrepreneurs through the Implementing Agencies.

5. The Government, after careful examination of the above proposal, hereby accord sanction an amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakh only) as trainee fee for 200 persons at Rs.5,000/- per trainee for one year towards short term training on Technical Textiles to impart Skill Development to the entrepreneurs through the empaneled Implementing Agencies under the purview of NTTM.

6. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.10,00,000/- will be provided in RE 2024-2025 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Textiles is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above. The Director of Textiles is also directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the budget proposal for RE / FMA 2024-2025 to Government in Finance (Ind) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
